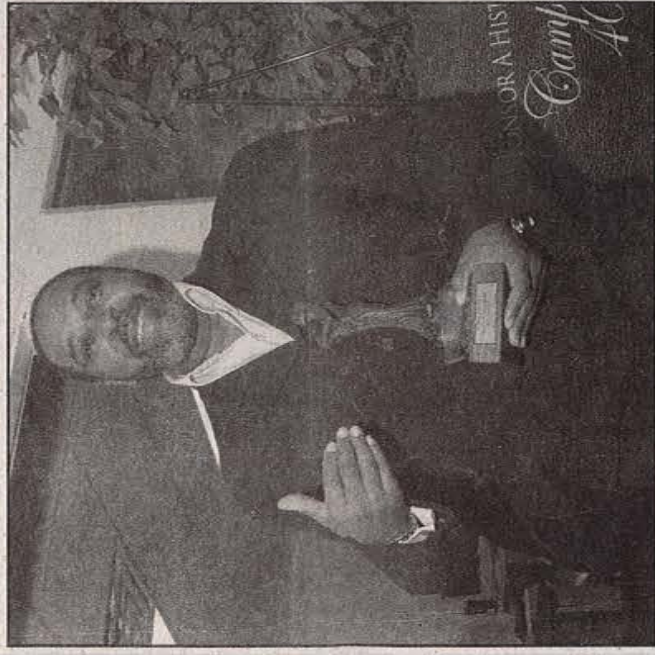


History Makers of Today, Yesterday and Tomorrow

The HistoryMakers represents the single largest archival project of its kind in the world, outdistancing the existing video oral history collections of New York's Schomburg Library and the Birmingham Civil Rights Museum. The HistoryMakers is unique among these other collections of African-American heritage, because of its massive scope. Like other oral history collections, The HistoryMakers collection hearkens back to the earliest and most authentic efforts to capture the voice of a people, while introducing state-of-the-art technology and increased accessibility. The HistoryMakers wants to provide living proof the african-American history did not begin or end with the civil rights movement, that the HistoryMakers number in the thousands and that their names are not just Harriet Tubman, W.E.B. DuBois, Martin Luther King, Jr and Ella Fitzgerald and just added Larry Huggins President of RiteWay Construction. Huggins interview was probably the last to be done in Chicago said Julieanna Richardson, executive director of HistoryMakers.

After a rigorous 3 1/2 hour interview Huggins was treated to a surprise birthday party given by Emilie McKendall and his daughters. Emerging from a private room Huggins was greeted by family friends and business associates. During the party Huggins was presented with a special trophy indicating his status as a HistoryMaker.
